Early voting

Advanced or early voting is now available in two locations through Nov. 2. Hours are 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday through Friday at the voter registration office, 204 W. Memorial Drive in Hinesville, or the Midway municipal courtroom, 10490 E. Oglethorpe Highway in Midway.

What to bring: ID forms

Voters must bring **one** of these six forms of identification to vote:

- Any valid state or federal government issued photo ID, including a free Voter ID Card issued by your county registrar’s office or the Georgia Department of Driver Services
- A Georgia Driver’s License, even if expired
- Valid employee photo ID from any branch, department, agency, or entity of the U.S. Government, Georgia or any county, municipality, board, authority or other entity of this state
- Valid U.S. passport ID
- Valid U.S. military photo ID
- Valid tribal photo ID

How to get a Georgia voter identification card

If you do not have one of the six acceptable forms of photo ID, Georgia offers a free voter identification card. An identification card can be issued at any county registrar’s office or Department of Driver Services Office free of charge. To receive a voter identification card, the voter must not have an any other form of identification that is acceptable under O.C.G.A. 21-2-417 for identification at the polls in order to vote. Documents required:

- Documentation showing your identity, residential address, full social security number, and U.S. citizenship or proof of lawful presence in the United States.
 - An original Certificate of Eligibility obtained from DDS.
- NOTE:** All documents must be in English.
