A special meeting of the Liberty County Public Facilities Authority (the "Authority") will be held at **4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 6, 2020**, at the offices of the Board of Commissioners of Liberty County, Room 2100, located in the Courthouse Annex at 112 N. Main Street, Hinesville, Georgia 31313, for the purpose of approving a resolution(s) authorizing issuance of Liberty County Public Facilities Authority Refunding Revenue Bonds (Justice Center Project), Series 2020, in the approximate principal amount of \$10,985,000 (the "2020 Justice Center Project Bonds"), to provide funds necessary to refund the Authority's outstanding Refunding Revenue Bond (Justice Center Project), Series 2017, the proceeds of which were used to refund the Authority's outstanding Revenue Bonds (Justice Center Project), Series 2009, which financed the cost of the acquisition, construction, and equipping of a new justice center for Liberty County.
